THE PROJECT

The continued, safe use of a historical, center of the community icon is at stake! Lobb Field, dedicated in May 2nd, 1971 by the people of Glendora in memory of John F. Lobb, is in a state of disrepair.

WHAT THE PROJECT ENTAILS

We are replacing sagging and distorted chain-link and rotten, deformed timber and rubber matting. Most materials and labor that are related to this project have been secured.

Most of the funds and materials related to this professionally quoted project, which is the renovation of the Lobb Field Backstop at Finkbiner Park in Glendora, normally costs approximately \$25,000 have been secured.

However, there is an outlying balance of \$1200 that is required to purchase final materials.

These funds MUST be obtained by June 24th, 2017 or the project will be cancelled, and we will not be able to set out on the mission to help our community's youth develop into strong, determined and excellence oriented young adults.
